











Serving three campuses for the 2021-22 school year, the Hynes Charter School family is a leader in quality public, open-enrollment education.

Hynes Charter School-Lakeview serves children in Gifted Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten-8th grades.

Hynes Charter School-UNO, opened in 2019 and replicated after its flagship school, currently serves children in Kindergarten-1st grades, adding a grade each year to grow into a full Kindergarten-8th grade campus.



The Hynes Model and Curriculum

Hynes offers a challenging academic curriculum that includes a progressive literacy program, gifted and talented courses, and classes in instrumental music, vocal music, library, theater, and physical education. Art and social-emotional learning are integrated throughout the curriculum, with a focus on diversity, equity and inclusion. Hynes provides an inclusive model for Special Education students. In addition, a French Immersion program is a choice for applicants. Hynes fosters a collaborative culture using a model of distributed leadership and shared decision-making.

Hynes is supported by internal and external stakeholders with an active parental, business, and neighborhood community. The school has strong partnerships with the University of New Orleans (UNO), Hancock Whitney, and Gulf Coast Bank.

ENHANCED LEARNING

The Hynes staff is 100% certified with over half holding advanced degrees in Education. Teachers use a variety of assessments to drive individualized instruction. Instructional facilitators measure student progress quarterly and work to ensure student achievement.

PBiS and Olweus Bully Prevention Program

School-wide structures, expectations, and incentives are embedded to promote a positive climate that improves social-emotional and academic outcomes for all students.

Specialized Foundation Riding for Focus Cycling Program

At the Lakeview Campus, the Riding for Focus curriculum integrates cycling into physical education classes as a way to help students achieve academic, health, and social success.

STARBASE

This week-long off-campus program for 5th graders at Jackson Barracks provides students with real world applications of math and science through experiential learning, simulations, and experiments in aviation and space-related fields.



Success for All (SFA)

SFA is a research-based literacy program developed at Johns Hopkins University which incorporates the five pillars of reading: phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, comprehension, and fluency. Teachers facilitate learning through student goal-setting and cooperative learning strategies.

Hancock/Whitney Bank at School Program Students' knowledge of financial literacy is enhanced with this program. Students are encouraged to save their money on a monthly basis by making deposits when the Hancock Whitney bankers come to school.

Junior Achievement (JA)

The JA curriculum inspires young people to succeed in a global economy. JA programs for elementary students include Finance Park, Financial Literacy Day, and BizTown.

FRENCH IMMERSION

Hynes is a Louisiana Department of Education World Language Certified School, offering a French Immersion program at its Lakeview and UNO Campuses for grades K-5th. All content follows the Louisiana State Standards.

The instructional staff are native speaking, French certified teachers.

Reading and English Language Arts (ELA) are taught in English.

PROJECT LEAD THE WAY

Hynes is a participant in Project Lead the Way (PLTW), which offers engineering and biomedical science programs. Grades K-5 implement PLTW Launch units during their science instruction. These

include units on Light and Sound,

Grids and Games, Programming
Patterns, Input/Output, and
Infection Detection. Grades
6-8 are enrolled in PLTW
Gateway electives
including Design and
Modeling, Automation
and Robotics, Coding,
and Computer Science.
PLTW lessons are aligned
with the National Science
Standards and encourage

careers in STEM.



ART, MUSIC & THEATER

Hynes partners with KIDsmART to link the arts with academic standards to create new connections between content and the different ways children learn. An artist-in-residence collaborates with Hynes classroom teachers to integrate art into their regular core content.

Hynes offers classes in vocal and instrumental music. Chorus and band are offered as extracurricular activities. In addition, all students have the opportunity to enroll in after-school enrichment programs in the visual arts, theater, and dance at various times throughout the year.





SPORTS AND ACTIVITIES

All Hynes campuses participate in the New Orleans Athletic League (NOAL) for grades 5-8. Sports offered at each campus include some or all of the following:

Hynes implements the Playworks model and the Junior Coach Leadership Program. The power of inclusive play develops students' social-emotional health. Fourth and fifth graders develop skills to lead games and assist their peers to mediate conflicts.

In addition, students can participate in:

- A's and Aces tennis and tutoring program promotes success on and off the court, combining professional tennis lessons with academic lessons.
- Girls on the Run and Heart and Sole encourage girls in grades
 3-5 and 6-8 to set and conquer personal goals and achieve
 them, culminating in a 5K in the Fall and Spring.

Hynes-UNO students in their first year exceeded math and reading targets from the 3rd quarter prior to school being disrupted by COVID-19




Closing the gap: minorities and economically disadvantaged students at Hynes outperformed the district average by nearly double
