10 Money-Saving Ideas for a Summer Barbecue



Make your outdoor grilling habit budget-friendly with these 10 easy tips



- **1. Don't Blow Your Budget on Meat-** You don't need to break the bank to do steak, chicken, or fish on the grill in style. Skip the porterhouse in favor of a great, inexpensive skirt or flank steak, or forego boneless chicken breasts for cheaper, flavorful legs and thighs.
- **2. Dress Up the Old Standbys -** If you're sticking with the tried-and-true standards (chicken, burgers, hot dogs, bratwursts), add a simple, inexpensive element to elevate the flavor. Stuff some blue cheese, chopped bacon, or barbecue sauce inside your burger patties before they hit the grill. Split your hot dogs lengthwise, add some cheddar in the middle and wrap the whole thing in bacon. Or let your chicken steep overnight in your favorite marinade. Get *creative*.
- **3. Make Extra -** When you're planning out your portions, grill enough for leftovers. By putting that fuel to work just one time to cook food for a couple days, you're actually decreasing your permeal fuel cost. To reheat, sprinkle the meat with water or sauce, wrap it in foil, and cook over indirect heat for 5 minutes.
- **4. DIY Rubs and Sauces -** Rubs are essentially spices that you can mix together yourself, and most sauces start with a basic foundation of ketchup or tomato sauce. Find some recipes that strike your palate's fancy, and test them out next time you fire up the grill.
- **5. Don't Go Overboard With Fuel -** Three pounds will cook any meal for 4 to 6 people. If you're using propane and cooking brisket or pork loin, put it on high for the first five minutes, then turn it on low to cook slowly. Turn the propane off right away when you're done.
- **6. Befriend Your Butcher -** Make friends with your butcher to find out about good sales. They're definitely the ones with the inside track. Build up that relationship, so you can find out which cuts have good prices because they're not as popular.
- **7. Invest in a Quality Grill -** You don't need to spring for a grill with loads of extra bells and whistles, but you do want to make sure you're getting one that won't fizzle out in two years. Buy just enough grill for what your family uses—possibly going for a bigger grill surface if you entertain a lot. You'll want enough space to multi-task. Also look for sturdy construction, so the grill won't tip over or crash.
- **8. Treat Your Grill Well -** Make maintenance a priority. Clean it off thoroughly before and after each use, get rid of the ashes when they've cooled and oil the grate before and after each use.
- **9. Minimize Your Accessories -**. You need two key grill accessories- a thermometer and tongs (avoid stabbing the meat with a fork because some of the delicious juices will escape.)
- **10. Do Your Homework -** If you're a beginning griller, take a minute to research step-by-step instructions on achieving grilling perfection or get a good instructional book to arm yourself with the techniques you need to make the tasty, grilled magic happen.

10 ROAD TRIP GAMES FOR KIDS

YOUR FAMILY IS ITCHING TO GET GOING; YOU'RE JUST ABOUT READY TO HEAD OUT ON ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR FORMS OF TRAVEL: THE FAMILY ROAD TRIP. ONE THING YOU ABSOLUTELY NEED TO HAVE IN THE CAR IS ENTERTAINMENT—ESPECIALLY IF YOU HAVE CHILDREN. NEED SOME IDEAS FOR YOUR UPCOMING ROAD TRIP? READ ON FOR SOME GREAT GAMES.



10: HUNTING FOR BOTTLED TREASURE- Fill a plastic bottle about three-quarters full with rice or birdseed. Add a variety of small household objects such as paperclips, buttons, marbles, toy Army men, etc. Keep track of what you put in. Your kids can then shake the bottle and try to find all of the treasures you "buried" in the bottle.

9: FUN WITH MAPS- Give your kids each a map and let them mark it up to help them keep track of where you are in your journey. Let them color, draw on it, highlight your route or use stickers to help them create their own personalized mementos of the trip.

8: COUNTING CARS - Your fellow drivers can provide the perfect opportunity for counting practice. Do challenges like being the 1st to find 5 blue cars or 10 semi-trucks.

7: **WATCH FOR PLATES** - Ask each person in the car how many different state license plates you'll see along the way. Write down everyone's guess and keep a list of all the states you see. Kids can mark off all the state plates they see on their maps.

6: GAMES GALORE - Bring a deck of cards or a board game. Several board games come in magnetic versions specifically designed for travel. Dry erase boards also provide a place to play games or draw without making a mess.

5: BE MEDIA SAVVY - Books, movies, music and games are all ways to keep your kids quiet for a longer period of time. Let them pick out a new book or movie they can read or watch during the ride. You may also want to consider limiting "screen time" so that you have enough opportunities to connect as a family during the ride.

4: I SPY- Find a fixed object that everyone in the vehicle can see and say, "I spy with my little eye something that is ..." then give a clue as to what the object is. Everyone else in the car takes turns asking yes or no questions about the mystery object and guesses until someone guesses the right item.

8: REST STOP ATHLETICS - While you're stopped, help your children burn off some energy. Pack some small athletic gear in your car (squishy footballs and Frisbees) to get the entire family involved and the blood circulating. Or, make up some quick, simple outdoor games. Create fun races where everyone has to run from tree to tree in different ways. Getting everyone moving will make your driver more alert, and calm down your children, maybe so much that they'll nap for an hour.

2: CREATE A SCAVENGER HUNT - Create a list of items you think you'll see along the way. Make copies for all the passengers in the car, and as each person sees an item, he calls it out, another person in the car verifies it and he crosses it off his list. The first one to cross off the entire list wins. Also try creating a bingo card for each person.

1: SAY YOUR ABCS WITH BILLBOARDS - As you pass signs along the road, try to find each letter of the alphabet in order. The caveat is that you can only get one letter from each sign you drive by. When you see the letter, call it out. For example, you'd say, "I see an 'a' on 'dairy farm this exit'." No one else can call a letter from that sign. Even if it also said "fresh butter," you'd have to get the "b" from a different billboard.



STILL NOT SURE HOW TO PROPERLY TIE THAT TIE?

Here's your step-by-step guide to The Windsor necktie knot which gives you a wide triangular tie knot that's good for more formal settings. This tie knot is best worn with a wide spread collar.

- 1. Drape the tie around your neck. The wide end should extend about 12 inches below the narrow end of the tie. Cross the wide part of the tie over the narrow end.
- 2. Bring the wide end of the tie up through the hole between your collar and the tie. Then pull it down toward the front.
- 3. Bring the wide end behind the narrow end and to the right.
- 4. Pull the wide end back through the loop again. You should have a triangle now where the necktie knot will be.
- 5. Wrap the wide end around the triangle by pulling the wide end from right to left.
- 6. Bring the wide end up through the loop a third time.
- 7. Pull the wide end through the knot in front.
- 8. Tighten the knot and center it with both hands.
