

ENRON by Lucy Prebble

Almost 25 years after the events that led to the fall of energy giant Enron, Lucy Prebble's award-winning genre-bending 2009 play still has much to say about the financial systems that shape our world, and the greed and corruption of those who bend the rules to make more than their fair share.

Welcome to Texas, the beating heart of the US gas industry, for the biggest corporate scandal in recent history.

Enron premiered at the Minerva Festival Theatre, Chichester, on 11th July 2009 and transferred to the Royal Court on 17th September 2009, before opening in the West End and on Broadway in Spring 2010.

DIRECTOR DANIEL GOLDMAN

George Wells - (Arthur Anderson, Richard Grubman, Trader)




