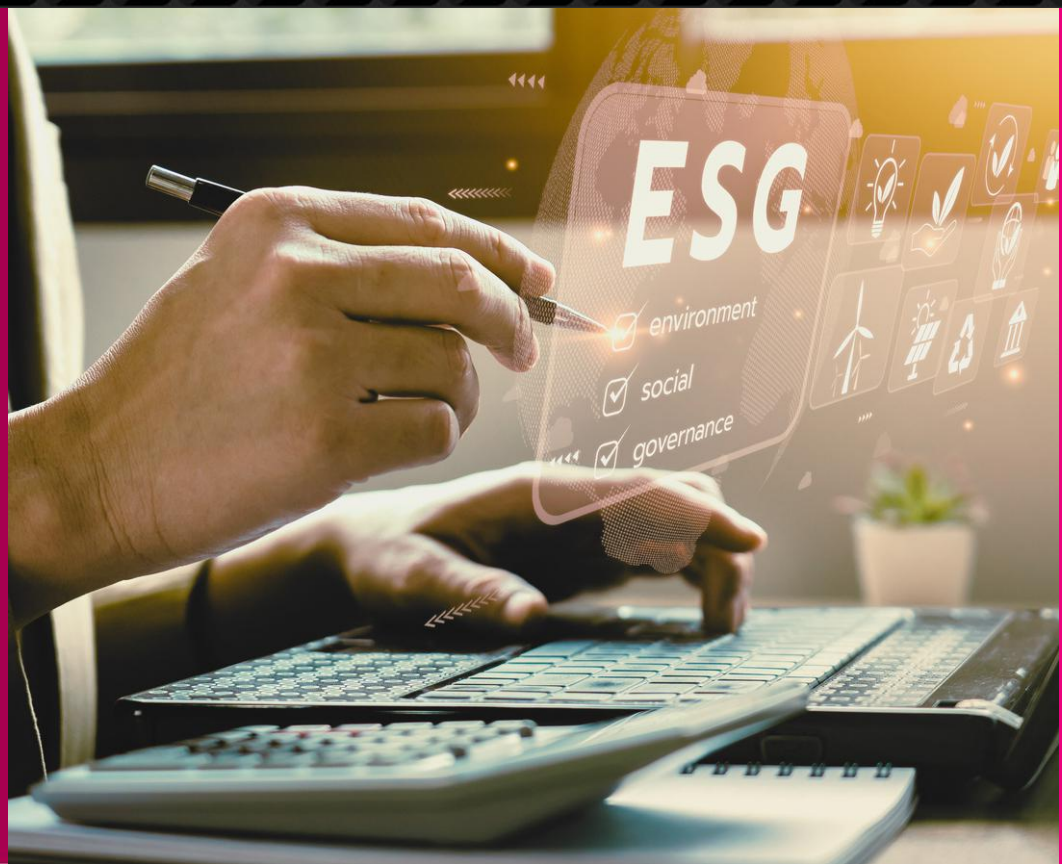

Examine and critically evaluate the challenges of doing business across national boundaries from the perspective of an individual manager, or organisation.

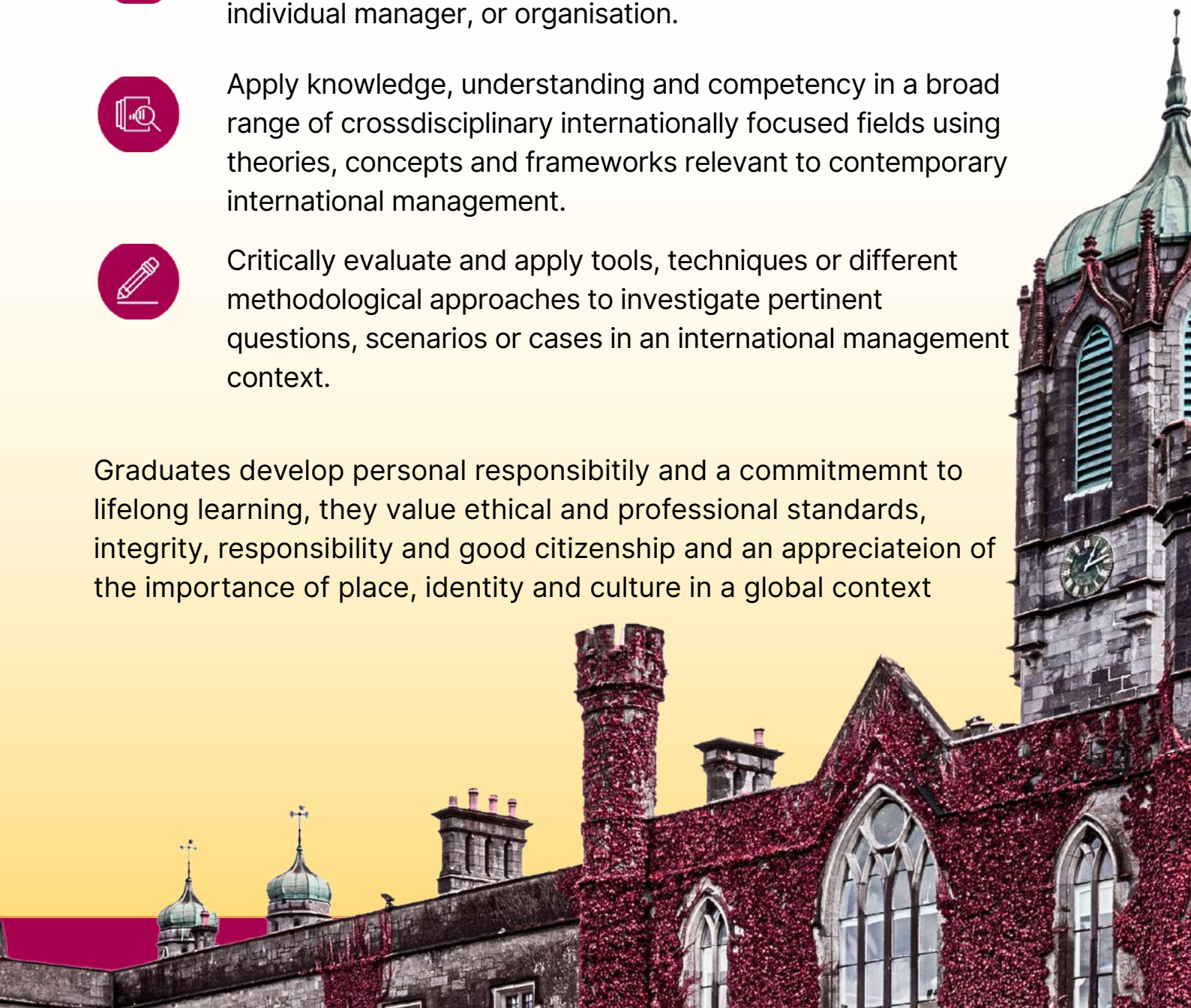


Apply knowledge, understanding and competency in a broad range of crossdisciplinary internationally focused fields using theories, concepts and frameworks relevant to contemporary international management.
