

Dishing Out the Veggie Vibes

ONE FAMILY'S JOURNEY TO PLANT HOOD, AND WHY WE HAVEN'T LOOKED BACK!

Buckle up, because this plant mama of two (plus one lovely step-munchkin) is about to spill the chickpeas on why our family swapped the cow milk for the greens. Was it ethical enlightenment, eco-epiphany, or a quest for kale-fuelled vitality? A bit of everything, really.

Why We Went Plant-Based

For me, it's almost like coming full circle, I was on and off vegetarian as a teenager right up until I was 20, so plant forward eating was never completely unfamiliar. But as an adult, our family had a full on ethical awakening. One evening, my husband and I found ourselves asking: Do we want to be friends with cows or have them on our dinner plates?

Spoiler alert: the mooing won our hearts. So tofu took centre stage, and bacon quietly bowed out.

I also found myself deep in the world of food documentaries. Watching titles like What the Health, Cowspiracy, Seaspiracy, and You Are What You Eat helped solidify our decision. Seeing the environmental and ethical impact of animal agriculture was eye-opening - and something I couldn't unsee.

The Health Boost

Within just 10 days of cutting out animal products, my energy levels soared. I felt lighter, more awake, and less sluggish after meals. It turns out, plant protein is easier to digest than meat – which might explain that sudden spring in my step.

Studies suggest that a plant-based diet can lower the risk of heart disease, support blood sugar control, and help with weight management. And yes, you really can get all the nutrients and vitamins you need from plants (with a bit of planning).

The Challenges – and the Comebacks

Of course, going plant-based as a family hasn't been without its awkward moments. We've dodged more than a few side-eyes at family barbecues and navigated restaurant menus with military precision. My advice? Stay informed. Share facts gently. And when in doubt, ask: What's more important – taste or life?

Raising Plant-Based Kids

Bringing up plant-based kiddos is a balance of principles and flexibility. Here's what's worked for us:

Start Small: Introduce plant-based swaps gradually - like lentil Bolognese or sweet 'n' sour tofu.

Get Them Involved: Kids are more likely to try meals they've helped prepare.

Stock Up on Alternatives: Oat milk is our go-to! We absolutely love the plant-based Babybels and plant-based Dairylea Jumbo Tubes.

Keep Communication Open: Let schools and nurseries know your child's dietary needs - ours have been really supportive.

Be Flexible: While we stick to a plant lifestyle dayto-day, we take a vegetarian approach at parties & events, so our kids can fully join in celebrations without feeling excluded.

Final Thought

Transitioning to a plant-based lifestyle doesn't have to be overwhelming. Take it one step – or one lentil – at a time.

SWEETS, SPOOKS & SAFETY: A PARENT'S GUIDE TO A CAIM HAILOWEEN by Sammy Davies

For some little ones, Halloween is the highlight of the year - costumes, spooky fun, and a bucket-load of sweets. But with excited kids running around in the dark (often full of sugar!), there are a few safety hiccups that can creep up if we're not prepared.

Costume Safety: What to Check

- Look for a CE tag on costumes. It doesn't mean it's fireproof, but it does mean the fabric has been safety tested.
- Layer up with natural fabrics (like cotton) under the costume.
 It offers extra protection in case of flames and keeps little ones warmer.
- Avoid bulky costumes in the car- just like with winter coats, pop the costume on when you arrive at your destination.
- Ditch the Flames, Keep the Glow. Skip open flame tea lights...
 excited kids + real fire = a risky combo. Use LED tealights
 instead, but keep them out of reach. Most contain button
 batteries, which can be very dangerous if swallowed.
- Help kids be seen in the dark. Sew in reflective tape, or just give them a torch.

Choking Hazards: A Spooky Truth

Sweets can be hard (hello, boiled sweets), sticky (chewy toffees), and squishy (we're looking at you, marshmallows).

Here are some reminders to reduce choking risk:

- Supervise your child while they eat
- Encourage them to sit down while eating
- Sort through the loot and quietly remove anything risky (Enjoy those ones with a cuppa later!)

Allergy-Safe Trick-or-Treating

Allergy parents, you've probably already got this covered- but **a few** safe treats in the bag or handed out to neighbours never hurts.

You're doing an amazing job.

And lastly, have you considered inviting **the Switch Witch?**She's the sneaky sidekick who swaps out some of the trickier treats for something a bit more fun- like **a small toy or book**. Less sugar, fewer risks, and still all the Halloween magic.

Hope that takes a bit of the fright out of your night... have a cracker of a Halloween!

-VEGETABLE & LENTIL PUFF PASTRY LEAVES

The perfect mix of comfort and creativity - a delicious and fun way to incorporate extra veggies into meals.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1-2 Rolls of puff pastry
- 200-250g Butternut Squash
- 1 tbsp oil or butter
- 1 small onion, finely chopped
- 1/2 large courgette, finely diced
- 2 garlic cloves (minced)
- 1 tsp dried sage or type
- ½ tsp smoked paprika
- ullet ½ can of green or brown lentils
- 75g grated cheddar cheese
- Egg or milk (for pastry wash)

MAKES: 6 LARGE 'LEAVES'
SUITABLE FROM 6 MONTHS

METHOD:

1 Preheat oven to 180°c and line a flat baking sheet.

2 Cook your butternut squash: either microwave it for 5-6 minutes or steam it until soft. Then, lightly mash with a fork until broken down.

3 In a dry pan, heat oil and add the onion. Sauté for 4-5 minutes. Add the diced courgette and cook for 4-5 minutes, until tender.

4 Stir in garlic, herbs, and spices. Cook for 1 min.

Mix the mashed squash, lentils, and vegetables in a bowl. When slightly cooler, stir in the cheese.

6 Roll out the pastry and cut out 2 identical leaf shapes. Repeat for as many leaves as you're making.

7 Fill a leaf with 1 heaped tbsp of the veg mix, leaving a margin for sealing. Place another pastry leaf on top, and press the edges together with a fork. Score leaf 'veins' on top. Use a whisked egg or milk to brush pastry.

8 Bake for 20-25 minutes until puffed and golden!

We were absolutely thrilled to be chosen to review the Rainbocorns Babycorns Magical Rainbocorn Babies Mystery Capsule! I knew it would be a hit with my daughter, who adores dolls - and I was right. The moment she saw the capsule, she squealed with excitement, eager to discover which adorable Rainbocorn baby was inside.

The packaging added to the suspense, with layers to unwrap before revealing a magical crib and Echo, a beautiful doll with sparkling silver eyes. My 4-year-old was over the moon, and the gold slime included was a big bonus she absolutely adored.

Best of all, the packaging doubles as a crib, giving Echo a cosy little home. Even my 1-year-old joined in, popping the dummy into Echo's mouth and rocking her gently. I appreciated the thoughtful design, especially the safe storage space for small parts - handy with a toddler around.

THE POWER OF COMMUNICATION IN **SLEEP TRAINING** by Melanie Hastings



When we think about sleep training, many parents imagine routines, timings, or strategies but one of the most important (and often overlooked) tools is communication. Babies and toddlers may not understand every word we say, but they pick up so much from our tone, consistency, and the way we guide them through transitions.

Why communication matters

Imagine being put down in your cot or bed without any idea what's happening next. It would feel unsettling, wouldn't it? Our little ones feel the same. By communicating with them, we're helping them to understand what's coming and reassuring them that they're safe, even if things are changing.

Simple phrases such as "It's bedtime now, I'm here, it's time to lie down and go to sleep" give children clarity. They learn what is expected and feel reassured that they're not alone – even if you're no longer rocking, feeding, or holding them to sleep.

Communication builds trust

Sleep training is never about leaving a child to fend for themselves. It's about shifting how we support them, and that shift is so much smoother when communication is at the heart of it. When you tell your little one what's happening, you're showing them that you see them, you're listening, and you'll still be there to comfort them just in a different way

A family I recently worked with

I was supporting a family whose baby struggled to settle at bedtime. He would cry and resist lying down in his cot, and bedtime had become stressful for everyone. Together, we focused on communication. His mum began to calmly explain: "It's bedtime now, I'd like you to lie down and go to sleep. I'm here with you."

Within just a few nights, everything began to change. The baby started to relax, because he understood what was happening. Instead of confusion and resistance, he felt reassured by his mum's calm words and tone. Bedtime became peaceful, and the whole family felt the difference.

Putting it into practice at home

- Use the same phrases each night to create consistency.
- Speak gently and with reassurance your tone matters as much as your words.
- Tell your little one what's coming next, so they don't feel taken by surprise.
 - Remind them you're still there, even if you're supporting them in a new way.

When communication becomes part of your sleep approach, you're not just teaching your child to sleep you're building a foundation of trust, connection, and understanding that makes the whole process gentler for everyone.

We all love hearing our toddler's first words, but some toddlers can take a little longer than others to start speaking. Is there anything you can do to encourage those first words? Most definitely!

For children to communicate effectively, they need the means, reasons and opportunities to communicate. (D. Money, 1997)

The 'means' include pointing, facial expression, signing, pictures and speech. A 'reason' may include requesting food or a toy, or protesting about something. The 'opportunity' includes having the time and place to try out some lovely new words!

As a mum and a Speech and Language Therapist, I know how easily we learn exactly what our toddlers want, without them having to ask.... and there's the crux. Too often we anticipate our child's needs - we know when they're likely to want a drink or snack and provide it, which is very kind, but in doing so we take away their reasons to communicate!

If toddlers don't need to speak to meet their needs, they may not bother trying to speak!

Create reasons for your child to communicate with you, such as putting their favourite toy just out of reach so they need to 'ask' for help. Try putting desired objects in a clear plastic box your child can't open, so again they need to ask for your help. Offer choices at snack or play time, hold up the items as you offer them, or show pictures -

your child can point if they can't tell you verbally. Model the language as you show the items, for example, 'Banana or bread stick?'

Your child also needs opportunities to speak. Sometimes we get enthusiastic about talking to children when playing – often though, what we're actually doing is asking questions they may not vet have the words to answer!

Instead of asking, 'What have you got?' or, 'What's that?', reduce the pressure and narrate their play: 'A car, a red car!', 'Wow, a scary dinosaur!', 'You're pushing the train.' This provides a good model of language, but remember to pause occasionally so they have a chance to speak!

Pauses are very powerful – play 'ready, steady.... GO!' games; pausing after 'ready, steady...' gives your child the chance to provide the 'go!' themselves.

Finally, don't deny your child something if they can't ask with spoken words; communication can be verbal or non-verbal. If they use non-verbal communication, that's fine – just model the word as you give them what they are requesting. If you're worried your child's speech may be delayed, contact a Speech and Language Therapist for advice.






As a therapist who specialises in early childhood mental health - and as a mother myself - I've seen firsthand how powerful it is when parents shift from reacting to their toddler's behaviour to getting curious about it.

Curiosity is one of the six Seeds of Connection in what I call the Connection Garden - a concept I developed to help parents build emotionally safe, responsive relationships with their children. When seeds like attunement, playfulness, and repair are planted and nurtured consistently, the parent-child relationship grows stronger and more joyful.

But when connection is missing, or only offered conditionally, we end up in what I call the Connection Desert. It's a place where children feel misunderstood and emotionally thirsty - and parents feel isolated, burned out, and unsure how to move forward. Fortunately, we can always begin to plant new seeds - and Curiosity is one of the most transformative.

What Curiosity Really Means

Many of us were raised to believe that discipline means control. That a toddler's tantrum needs to be "fixed," or that whining should be ignored until it stops. But when we get curious instead and ask, "What's going on in there?", we begin to understand that behaviour is communication.

Toddlers don't have the language or brain development to say, "I'm overtired, overstimulated, and I miss you." So they cry, hit, throw, or resist. When we respond with curiosity instead of control, we teach them that it's safe to have big feelings - and we start to build lifelong skills for emotional health and relational trust.

The Power of Observation

One of the simplest, yet most profound, ways to cultivate curiosity in your relationship with your toddler is through observing them do what they do best: play. When you're just getting started with child observation. I recommend you make an effort to practice this intentionally for about 5-10 minutes a day. Eventually, this will become a natural part of your relationship with your toddler

Here's how it works:

Set up the play environment so that it is totally safe for your toddler. Creating a "Yes" space where everything is safe (including toys, things to climb, etc) encourages your toddler to discover their own interests and get lost in the magic of play. At the same time, it will help you to resist the urge to hover, intervene, or take charge of their play process.

Pull up a chair nearby, settle into your body, and simply notice your breath and any sensations that arise. See if you can observe yourself with the same curiosity you offer your child.



Once you feel settled, start to notice what your child is doing with their hands and where their eyes are looking. Following their hands and eyes allows you to become more connected to what their brain is curious about. Resist the urge to fix anything. If you see your toddler frustrated with stacking some blocks, you may feel it would be useful to offer your help. By doing so, you're undermining your child's intense drive toward mastery and competence. Instead, be curious with your toddler: "I wonder if that feels tough...I see you're not giving up." By resisting the urge to fix, control, change, or provide educational directives (e.g., "What colour is this?") while they play, you send the vital messages: I trust that you are competent. I'm curious about how you see things. I'm invested in knowing more about you.

Beware the "Monkey Mind." It's normal for your mind to wander - it might even feel boring to watch your toddler play. You don't have to love it. Just notice, and gently return your focus to what your child is doing. That's curiosity in action. The more you wonder about what they're doing and why it feels important to them, the more lush and vibrant your Connection Garden becomes.

In my experience with leading parents in observation exercises, many parents notice that they judge their children unintentionally: "Why doesn't my child behave like other kids?"Try to shift from judgement into wondering at what They are experiencing. That curiosity may help you see their behaviour not as a problem to correct, but as a strength to nurture

Why Observation Supports Independent Play

One of the beautiful benefits of using child observation consistently is that it nurtures your toddler's ability to engage in independent, imaginative play.

Your willingness to be more curious about their inner world, while resisting the urge to control, fix, or change it, will support your toddler with:

- · Playing without constant adult involvement
- · Developing longer attention span
- Resolving sibling conflicts with less need for intervention

Additionally, you'll be less likely to seek screens as a

virtual babysitter for your child, because your toddler will become a master at directing their own interests and commanding their physical space with confidence and courage.

Observation isn't passive - it's deeply relational. By watching and narrating without controlling, we say, "I'm interested in you. I delight in who you are." This kind of non-intrusive attention is both grounding and expansive for the developing toddler's mind.

How Curiosity Looks in the Hardest Moments

Here are some phrases you can try next time your toddler is having a moment that feels hard to manage:

- When your child is hitting: "You wanted that toy, and it was really hard to wait. I'm here to help."
- In the middle of a transition: "You weren't ready to leave. I get it - it's hard to stop playing when you're having fun."
- When siblings are fighting: "You both wanted the same thing. Let's take a breath and figure this out together."

What Gets in the Way of Curiosity?

Many parents tell me: "I know I shouldn't yell, but in the moment, I just lose it."

It makes perfect sense. If you were raised in a Connection Desert - where your own feelings were shamed, ignored, or punished - then of course it's hard to stay present with your child's big feelings. Your nervous system might interpret their distress as a threat.

That's why we must extend the same curiosity to ourselves that we do to our children. When we get dysregulated, instead of judging ourselves, we can ask, "What is this moment trying to teach me about what I need?"

This is the deep, healing work that I talk about in my book, Parent Yourself First.

Curiosity Is Connection

Your curiosity helps your toddler feel safe, seen, and supported. You tell them that they are not a problem to be fixed - but a person to be understood.

I know how easy it is to default to frustration, especially when you're exhausted or touched out. But if there's one thing I hope you take away from this, it's that curiosity is always available to you -


