ROH's Create & Learn Programme is a Flagship project that is designed to build teachers' creative confidence to facilitate learning through the arts. It is easily implemented by non-specialist teachers and is inclusive for every child. They connect their service to delivery of KS1-2 National Curriculum with each pathway offering authentic connections to ROH artists. The programme is split into 3 options, taking place over a term:

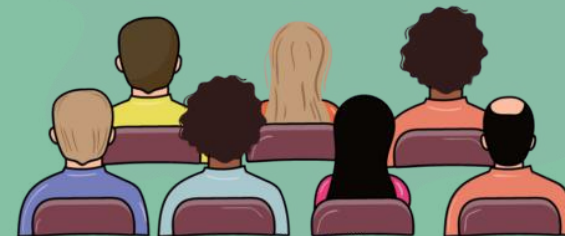

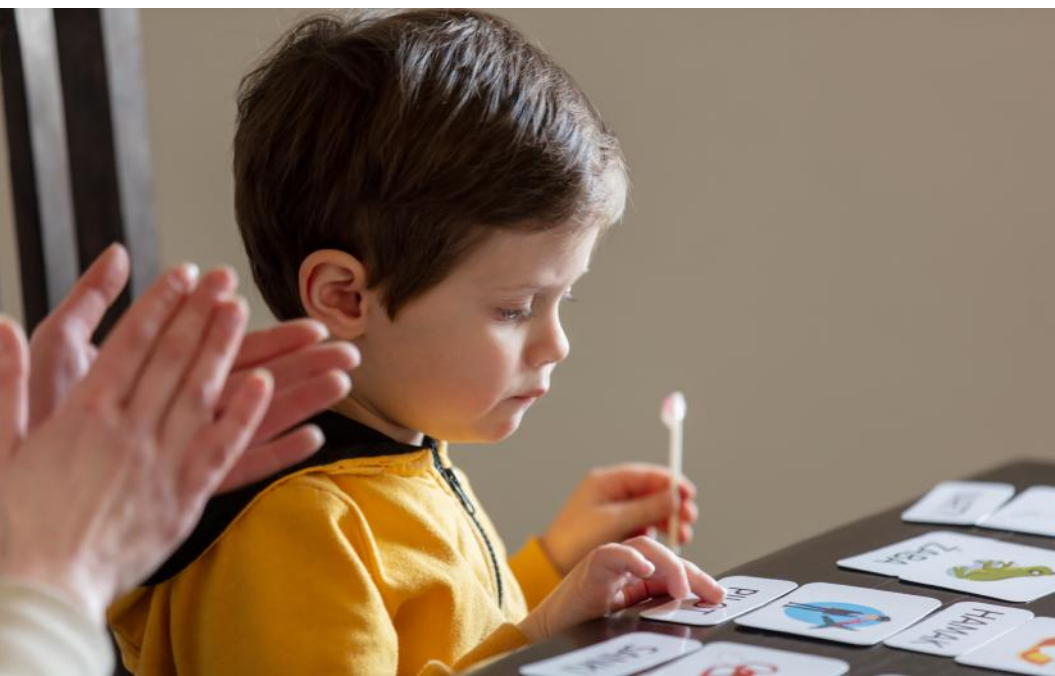

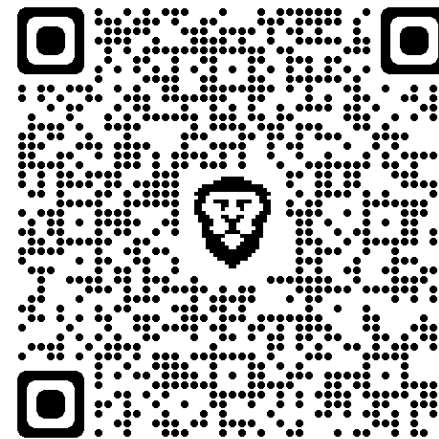
