In 1986, a small group of dedicated pioneers led by Pastors John and Joan Pennicook began meeting monthly in a lounge room to pray and plan for the birth of a Christian Life Centre Church in the Wyong Shire. Their unwavering faith and commitment set the foundation for what would eventually become Hope Unlimited Church, a thriving church with a global presence. The first service was held in Gorokan High School hall on the 1st of February 1987, with just 70 people in attendance. The beginning was humble but filled with great excitement. A regular morning service started on the 7th of June that year, and from there, the church continued to grow.

In 2011, Pastors Mark and Darlene Zschech relocated from Sydney to become the Lead Pastors, and HopeUC began to expand rapidly. Today, we have six campuses in NSW, Australia, on the Central Coast, with one in Charmhaven, Gosford, and the Peninsula, and three campuses in the Hunter Region, including Newcastle, Maitland, and Port Stephens.

Each campus has its unique history and story, with some starting as life groups or churches before joining the HopeUC family. Our Gosford campus, for example, began as a life group in the home of Mel and Matt Hope and officially started as a campus in 2012. Our Peninsula campus started when Sam and Kylie Collins from Good News Church joined HopeUC in April 2013 and has a history that stretches back to when it was started by Pastors Pat and Brian Donovan in 1980.



Building on the Legacy of those who came before us

Our Newcastle campus was started in the late 1960s and grew to become Globe Church with Pastors Bruce and Kate Robertson, and is now known as our HopeUC Newcastle campus. HopeUC Maitland, planted by Grant and Megan Atherton in 2004, joined the church family in 2019. And then, in 2021, Baylife Church, planted by Pastors Greg and Robyn Mckewin in 2002, became part of the HopeUC family, adding to the growing presence of the church in the Hunter Region.

HOPE GLOBAL Making a lasting impact

Hope Global is committed to creating long-lasting change through investment in our projects and partners. Over the past year, we have had many opportunities to give and be a blessing to communities around the world.

FRUITS OF HOPE ACADEMY, RWANDA

Our Fruits of Hope Academy continues to grow and develop, with 630 students and 35 staff enrolled for the school year. Our school's academic performance remains outstanding, with over 98% of students achieving in the top bands of the national exams. However, many families have faced financial challenges due to the pandemic. To help, we have sponsored 20 students school fees for the year and are exploring creating a sponsorship project to assist struggling families.

HOPE GLOBAL CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE, RWANDA

We are excited to announce that the draft designs for our Centre of Excellence have been finalised with the help of two architects from SylvesterFuller. The project aims to empower and upskill local men and women in Rwanda, as well as those from neighbouring countries. We hope to begin construction in 2024.

LEGACY KIDS - HOPE CARRIER

Our Hope Carrier Project continues to support children in need, with 2488 new school bags filled with essential supplies distributed across India, Thailand, and South Africa. Through our Kids team efforts and their Legacy giving, \$3750 was raised to sponsor 100 school bags in India. Hope Global's Chairman, Matt Hope, and his son, Jamin, had the privilege of distributing these bags in September 2022.

MINDORO, PHILIPPINES

Scott and Ruth Buchanan are back on the Island of Mindoro in the Philippines, building relationships and impacting the local community. Their focus is on strengthening the existing indigenous church to plant new churches among unreached tribes.

VANUATU CYCLONE RELIEF

Hope Global has donated funds to Liberty People to help cover the costs of sending a container filled with canned food and building supplies to Vanuatu, which was hit by several cyclones in March 2023.

YOUTH CAMP SPONSORSHIP, SAMAR PHILIPPINES

We were given the opportunity to sponsor a Youth Camp in Samar, Philippines, where disadvantaged youth make up a large proportion of the population. The camp in July 2023 is expected to have over 700 participants between the ages of 13 and 25, and we believe it will be a great blessing to the community.

UKRAINE

Hope Global and HopeUC have donated over \$35k to aid war relief efforts in Ukraine. In addition, Pastor Wayne Zschech and his team are innovating ways to make a difference, including launching the first wood waste-to-energy project by the end of the warm season. We encourage everyone to keep Pastor Wayne, Olya, and their family in their prayers.

SRI LANKA

Narel and Alison Atkinson have been diligent partners in Sri Lanka, and in addition to providing monthly support, we were able to send funds towards emergency food parcels to 125 families during the economic crisis that hit the nation in the past year. In April 2023, our Sisters of HopeUC also gave over \$5800 towards a women's conference in Sri Lanka, which will be a great blessing to thousands of families in the region.

THE GOING, JULY 2023

We are grateful for the opportunity to send over 70 volunteers to connect with our partners overseas. Our teams will be building houses, setting up a free education center for street kids, and conducting various community outreach programs in Bali, Vanuatu, Sri Lanka, India, and Dubbo. All our teams are raising funds for the various projects they will be involved in, and we would appreciate your prayers for their success.

Spreading Love in Our Community and Beyond

HopeLocal is a passionate army of volunteers within our church who consistently love people in our community, schools, and beyond. They gather in school ministries, campuses, and other locations to be the hands and feet of Jesus each week.

DISASTER RESPONSE & CHAPLAINCY

This year, we've continued aiding flood-affected regions from Northern Rivers to Eugowra and our own Maitland. The community response has been overwhelming, witnessing our active and compassionate church. In a GOING project, over 20 Maitland volunteers cleaned houses, brought food, coffee, and smiles to flooded locals.

We have chaplains responding and caring for people weekly in various settings such as ambulances, sports, hospitals, and more. A big thanks to all who serve in this capacity.





THE GOING

Each campus partners with local charities in July/ August to support and enhance their ongoing efforts. Last year, in Port Stephens, we supported Hope In A Suitcase by packing suitcases for children in foster care. As a church, we also donated \$12,000 to this initiative during Christmas.

Newcastle campus distributed cards and grocery vouchers to local organisations and actively supported the "I Run For Her" campaign, a domestic violence awareness initiative in partnership with 'Got Your Back Sista.' The walk in Maitland saw over 80 participants and garnered attention from the local television station.

SCHOOLS

Our GU leaders engage in high school ministries, cooking thousands of pancakes in breakfast programs and running initiatives during lunchtime and for overall well-being. We continue to run the Shine program for girls and provide SRE (Special Religious Education) in primary schools, making a remarkable impact.








MEALS OF HOPE / GIFTS OF HOPE

We respond to food insecurity on a weekly basis, providing Meals of Hope and food hampers at each campus. Charmhaven campus's "Free Food" program, supported by Oz Harvest and Aldi, assists numerous families. We feel privileged to be able to support those in need.

In the past year, we distributed over 5000 meals, hampers, and gifts across our campuses. Additionally, our campuses offer community spaces where individuals can connect for conversations, meals, receive vouchers, pastoral care, and even medical assistance.

CAN WE PRAY FOR YOU?




