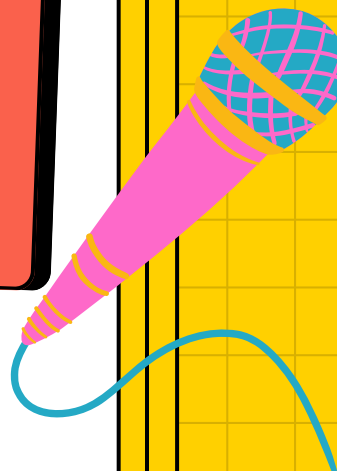

Who is eligible to swim for The Bent Creek Country Club Swim Team?

All children and grandchildren of current Golf, Sports or Social Members of Bent Creek Country Club are eligible to join.

Are lifeguards able to join the team?

Any current Lifeguard of Bent Creek Country Club is eligible to join.

What ages can join the team?

Swimmers must be 5 years old as of June 1st.

What if my child doesn't know how to swim?

Swimmers must be able to swim 25 meters in deep water, without stopping.

How do I register my children?

Swimmers must complete the online registration form on the swim team website.

How much is registration?

Registration fees are \$150.00 per swimmer and will be charged to your member number.

What equipment is needed to swim?

A tight-fitting one-piece suit in either navy blue or black and goggles that fit tight to the face, enhance vision, and protect from chlorine.

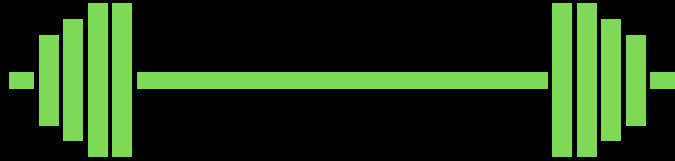

Bent Creek Golf Course Renovation Update

Spring is in full swing, and with it comes exciting progress on our golf course renovation! Over the past two months, our dedicated teams have been working tirelessly to bring these enhancements to life, despite the challenges of fluctuating temperatures and unpredictable weather. We're thrilled to report that we remain on schedule, with bunker renovations nearing completion and tee renovations progressing rapidly.

Bunker Project Nears Completion

The finish line is in sight for our bunker renovations, with final drainage and concrete installation on hole #9 set to wrap up next week. Bunker sand installation continues, with only a few remaining holes left to be completed. The short-range bunkers will be the final touch, ensuring a consistent and high-quality playing experience across the course.

Tee Renovations Gaining Momentum

As bunker work winds down, tee renovations have taken center stage. Demolition and rough grading have been completed on holes 11, 13, and 14-18, with work currently underway on 14 and 15. Irrigation installation is set to resume next week, a critical step toward preparing these areas for play.

Sod Installation & Course Playability

Sodding efforts have been ongoing, transforming several key areas:

- Hole #3 – Sod installation is now complete.
- Hole #4 – Final sod work is being finished.
- Holes #5-9 – Sodding will continue through next week.
- To ensure the best possible conditions for the upcoming season, we ask all members to respect course signage, ropes, and stakes, allowing these newly sodded areas to properly establish.

Course Reminders & Temporary Adjustments

- Cart Path Only on holes 3, 4, 5, 8, and 17 to protect freshly sodded areas.
- Temporary Tees are in place on holes 1, 10, 11, 13, and 15-18 (please use black/gold tee markers).
- Newly Constructed Tees Remain CLOSED – Please refrain from use to ensure proper establishment.
- Back Nine & Hole #1 Playability – All grass areas are open for play, except for designated fairway/approach areas (watch for signs).

FROM THE RED TEES

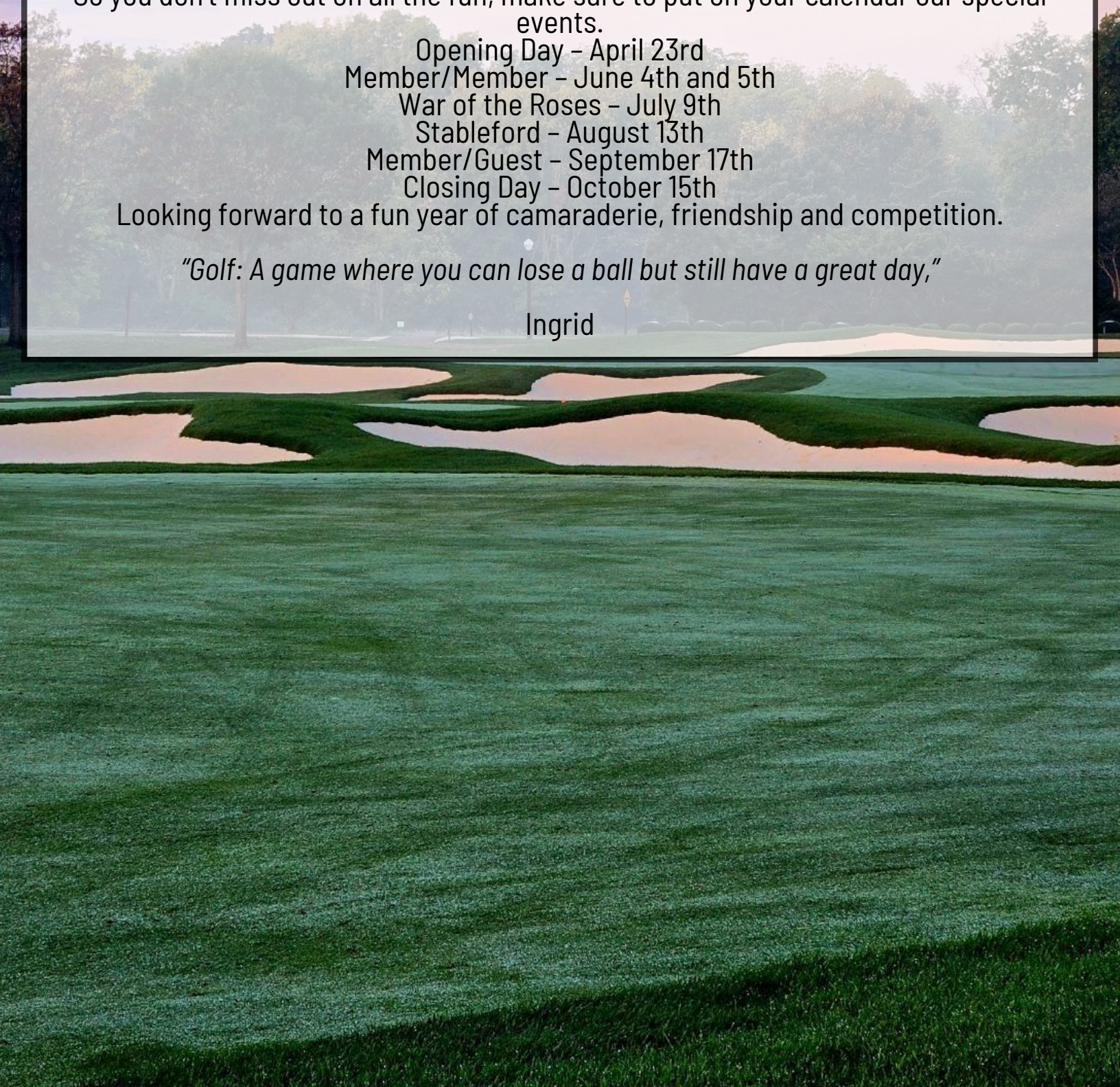

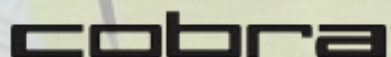

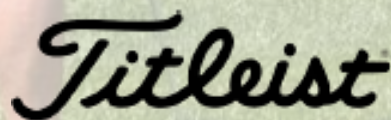

Pickleball Playbook – Tip of the Month

The serve is important for obvious reasons since it begins every rally. When I teach students privately or in clinics, I always mention that it is the only shot you have 100% control of since no one is feeding you the ball. It is in your hand and you have 10 feet to move from side to side.

As a result, we should focus on:

The 10 Commandments about the Serve

1. Keep the serve in-bounds. Remember you can never win a point if the serve is not in play!
2. Hit the serve deep. The returner is attempting to return the ball and advance to the non-volley zone (NVZ) line. The longer you make that person hit and run the more you create an advantage.
3. Stay behind the baseline until the return of serve is struck. As a member of the serving team, you MUST let the returned ball bounce prior to you hitting the third shot of the rally. If you get caught moving forward into the shot this will not allow you to setup correctly for an accurate shot. No good shot come from hitting while leaning or moving backwards.
4. Target the returner's backhand. Typically, a player's backhand is not as strong or proficient as his/her forehand.
5. Add speed and/or spin to the serve. Anything extra you can add to your serve to make it just a little more difficult for the returner creates a small advantage that you might get a weak or missed return. If you are proficient with spin or speed, try both on the same serve!
6. Flatten the service motion to add speed, heighten the motion to add depth. A more shallow or flat serve will appear faster and is necessary to stay in bounds. Since it is gravity that makes your serve come down use height on a serve and it will take longer to come down and therefor add depth to your serve.
7. Keep it legal. Know the 3 components that make a volley serve legal which are height and paddle head at contact point and an upward motion.
8. Vary the speed and direction of the serve. Keep your opponents guessing about your serve.
9. Choose an offensive or defensive position from where to serve. For offense you can stand along the service line in a position to use the best angle for your serve. For defense if they have a nice wide return you may want to serve from the corners.
10. Practice serves...with a purpose. As with any shot in pickleball or other sports it takes practice. If you are not sure if you are doing it right or not sure what to practice, I am here to help you. Please reach out to me through the pro shop and we can book some time together!
