Join us on a unique summertime expedition through the remote waterways of Alaska's Inside Passage aboard the 76-guest Chichagof Dream. While exploring some of nature's more secluded landscapes, encounter Alaska's abundant wildlife, breathtaking scenery, and ice-blue glaciers of unfathomable proportions.

Alongside expert naturalists and knowledgeable on-board crew, navigate narrow channels and remote coves inaccessible by larger vessels. Witness enormous whales breaching next to your boat, bears hunting along the shoreline, and eagles soaring overhead—all thrilling performances of nature's amazing show.

This program also offers an optional pre-tour to Denali National Park—home to Denali, the highest mountain in North America. Ride the Alaska Railroad, stay at a hilltop lodge just north of the park entrance, and explore this vast and stunningly beautiful wilderness, recognizing why it's become one of our nation's most breathtaking conservation areas.

Space is limited. With significant savings of more than \$1,000 per couple, we anticipate this tour will fill quickly.

Featuring Professor Paul Barber



Paul Barber is a professor of Ecology and Evolutionary Biology at UCLA. He studied Ecology and Evolutionary Biology and Music at his home town University of Arizona, and then earned his PhD from UC Berkeley in 1998. Paul spent 3 years at Harvard as an NSF Minority Postdoctoral Fellow before joining the faculty at Boston University in 2002 and then UCLA in 2008. Paul's research program integrates genetics, genomics, ecology, and oceanography to understand the evolution of marine biodiversity, and uses this information to promote marine conservation. The majority of this research is done in the context of education programs like The Diversity


Project, a program focused on increasing participation of underrepresented minorities in marine science. Paul's integration of research and education and passion for mentoring diversity in science has been recognized by numerous awards, including the U.S. Presidential Early Career Award for Science and Engineering, the UCLA Distinguished Teaching award, the UCLA Diversity Equity and Inclusion Award, UCLA Gold Shield Prize, and the SACNAS Distinguished Student Mentor Award. In 2017 he was named an HHMI Professor.

Itinerary and Highlights (subject to change)

- Day 1: ARRIVE IN SITKA, AK EMBARKATION Arrive in Sitka from your home city or from Anchorage if you joined the optional pre-tour. Meet with a local guide to tour the Alaska Raptor Center— Alaska's foremost bald eagle hospital and educational center. Next visit Sitka National Historical Park. Later board the Chichagof Dream for embarkation. Overnight: Chichagof Dream (D)
- Day 2: ICY STRAIT Enjoy prime viewing on deck while spotting for wildlife including orcas, Steller sea lions, seals, porpoises and magnificent humpback whales. There will be opportunities for skiff rides and hiking (weather permitting). Overnight: Chichagof Dream (B,L,D)
- Day 3: GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK Explore aweinspiring Glacier Bay National Park and Bartlett Cove, watching for puffins, bears and eagles. Overnight: Chichagof Dream (B,L,D)
- Day 4: LAKE EVA Spend the morning cruising through the Peril Strait to Hanus Bay. In the afternoon enjoy free time at Lake Eva to take a guided hike, or join a skiff excursion if conditions permit.

Overnight: Chichagof Dream (B,L,D)

- Day 5: EASTERN BARANOF ISLAND I HIDDEN FALLS Experience a rare tour of Hidden Falls Hatchery and learn about the release of Chinook, coho, and chum salmon fry and smolts, and the vital role fishing has played in Alaska for centuries. Overnight: Chichagof Dream (B,L,D)
- Day 6: PETERSBURG I FREDERICK SOUND Visit a charming fishing village followed by a hike along a historical trail. Overnight: Chichagof Dream (B,L,D)
- Day 7: TRACY ARM FJORD Witness the incredible sight of glaciers calving as gigantic ice chunks break off and crash into the water. This afternoon, conditions permitting, set off on a skiff ride to further explore the area's bays and coves. Tonight gather together for a special Captain's Farewell Dinner to celebrate your adventures touring the Alaskan wilderness. Overnight: *Chichagof Dream* (B,L,D)
- Day 8: AUKE BAY I JUNEAU DISEMBARKATION I DEPART JUNEAU After breakfast disembark and take the complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home. If you reserved an additional night in Juneau, take a complimentary shuttle to your accommodations. (B)







The itinerary and daily activities (including skiff rides, kayaking and hiking) are subject to change based on weather, wildlife viewing and navigation conditions.

Activity Level: This program offers a variety of activities, typically not strenuous for guests with average mobility, including skiff rides, hiking and kayaking. Walks and hikes are at a leisurely pace in order to see and learn as much as possible about the region. It's our expectation that guests are able to walk with good balance, and go up and down stairs easily without assistance. NOTE: The *Chichagof Dream* does not have an elevator.



What's Included

- 7 nights aboard the Chichagof Dream
- All onboard hand-crafted meals: 7 breakfasts, 6 lunches and 7 dinners—including a special Captain's Farewell Dinner, and complimentary wine and beer at dinner
- An onboard lecture program and educational guidance of two naturalists plus an Orbridge **Expedition Leader**
- Guided kayaking, hiking, walking, skiff excursions and wildlife viewing where humpback whales, orcas, brown bears, Steller sea lions, harbor seals, sea otters, arctic terns, bald eagles and other populations are frequently spotted
- All port fees and entry fees to parks, preserves, museums, attractions and special excursions as described in the itinerary
- Gratuities for Orbridge Expedition Leader, airport transfer drivers and drivers/guides on included land excursions
- Airport transfers for guests arriving and departing during the suggested times

Aboard the agile Chichagof Dream, you'll gain exclusive access to channels and bays inaccessible to larger vessels. The ship's unassuming style allows guests to experience the true heart and soul of Alaska.

The Chichagof Dream features expansive viewing areas on the bow and aft outdoor promenade decks, a hull design optimized for supreme comfort in Alaskan waters, and forward-facing windows in the spacious lounge that extend from the deck to the ceiling, offering panoramic views off the bow.





Journey into the scenic wilds of America's most northern state, through Alaska's rugged forests and wildlife. A highlight of this adventure includes an afternoon traveling aboard the historic Alaska Railroad with superior viewing from your upgraded glass-dome seat.

Day +2: FAIRBANKS I ALASKA RAILROAD I DENALI NATIONAL PARK Board the train to Denali National Park. At the park gather for a brief orientation, and register for available activities and excursions. Overnight: Grande Denali Lodge (B,D)

Day +3: DENALI NATIONAL PARK WILDERNESS EXCURSION Take a guided walking tour through Denali's wilderness to learn about its landscapes, wildlife and history. Redeem your Alpenglow Restaurant dinner voucher either tonight or

tomorrow evening.

Overnight: Grande Denali Lodge (B,L,D)

- Day +4: DENALI NATIONAL PARK After breakfast participate in one of the pre-purchased optional excursions or enjoy free time to explore Denali. Later, reconvene for a reception with Alaskan homesteader, Jimmie Hendricks, and hear his journey and lifelong dream to explore Alaska and make it his home. Overnight: Grande Denali Lodge (B,R)
- Day +5: DENALI NATIONAL PARK I TALKEETNA I ANCHORAGE Continue to Anchorage by motor coach stopping for free time in Talkeetna. Visit the Alaska Native Heritage Center in Anchorage. Overnight: Hotel Captain Cook (B)
- Day +6: DEPART ANCHORAGE Take the complimentary transfer to Anchorage International Airport for the group flight to join guests on the main program.
