Lend-A-Paw Program Kick-off

The We Love Doggos Hero Club is proud to announce a new initiative that helps support one of our Charity's 3 pillars of hope: advocating, transporting and treating.

In this case, it is covering medical treatment costs for dogs needing emergency, typically life-saving procedures. The **Lend-A-Paw Program** supports the vets, treatment facilities and organizations that are the first to know of such needs.



We are happy to announce that Dr. Wolf, a retired vet from Acworth, Georgia is the first recipient of a Lend-A-Paw grant. Specifically, the Hero Club, through this program, was able to pay the treatment costs for Blue. This sweet little chihuahua was hit by a car and broke his rear leg in several places. His parents couldn't afford the surgery and were considering putting him down...until THE HERO CLUB came to the rescue!

Now he is happy, curled up on his favorite blanket and recuperating with his family.



But that's not the best part of this story!

Dr. Wolf spent his entire veterinary career saving dogs with the hopes of retiring to do what he really loves doing...saving dogs! Instead, now he does it from his mobile van and he does it for FREE, donating all of his time and energy saving injured and sick Doggos owned by underprivileged families that would otherwise not be able to afford the life-saving care.

THAT is what a true Hooman Hero looks like.

MISSION PAWSIBLE

This May the We Love Doggos Hero Club began its search for an overcrowded, underfunded animal shelter to sponsor. We wanted to bring attention to the nationwide shelter crowding problem and help hundreds of dogs at the same time.

Congratulations to the Mission Valley Animal Shelter in Ronan, Montana our first "Mission PAWsible" awardee!



This underfunded, overcrowded shelter is just an hour's drive from our headquarters. They save, on average, 400 homeless, abused, sick and injured dogs a year.



During our Charity Director, Terry Williamson's first trip to the facility in June, he noticed that the facility had no air conditioning, even though it was 95 degrees! Our Hero Club immediately funded the purchase of two air conditioning units and 25 Doggos spent the rest of the summer cool as clams!

Earlier this month he visited again and met with Reava, the shelter manager, to discuss "Operation Barkyard", a plan to install a new outdoor dog play area and meet and greet area. The Hero Club's \$10,000 donation will not only give the dogs in the shelter hours of fun, but increase the number of adoptions!



Finally, just a few days ago, the We Love Doggos Hero Club sponsored **Wags and Whiskers**, the shelter's annual fundraising campaign.








