



MADL partnered with Bethlehem Park Neighborhood Association to create a sweet respite from the hustle and bustle of the city streets with Muskegon Heights' first Story Trail. Nestled under shade trees along a winding paved path, MADL's Story Trail is located in Bethlehem Park, just a half a mile from MADL's Muskegon Heights Branch. "Last Stop on Market Street" by Matt de la Pena was one of the first books chosen for the Story Trail, coinciding with the author's visit to Muskegon last fall for MADL's Big Read.

Soon, the book pages will be swapped out with a new book-"The Bear Ate Your Sandwich" by Julia Sarcone-Roach, a favorite of MADL's Early Literacy Coordinator Diana Wenger. "I love this book because it leaves kids with a questionwho really ate the sandwich?" Let your curiosity lead you to Bethlehem Park this summer.
