The Hero Club was born to bring you, our wonderful community members, into the dog rescue world. We combine our time and resources to support our charity partners, facilitate dog transports, cover veterinary bills, and engage in many more impactful initiatives.

We funded 11 dog transports, directly saving the lives of 89 dogs stuck in kill shelters.



We funded two missions to Mexico, where we provided treatment and vaccinations to over **500 homeless dogs**.



We're the architects behind a fabulous **200-square-foot shaded area** for dogs to relax at The Tobacco Valley Animal Shelter.



Our financial support spoke volumes – we aided three charity partners in rescuing an astounding 1,700 dogs in 2023!

Every single penny is dedicated to fueling our upcoming Mexican street dog vaccination expedition.







2023 Charity Partner of the Year, The Animal Pad!

Located in San Diego, CA, this heart-driven organization racked up some truly incredible stats last year.



But it's not just the stats that set them apart. It is the level of determination, love and commitment that Lauren and her all-volunteer staff display on a daily basis.

Time after time they say "YES" to a downtrodden dog when everybody else says "NO".

They are constantly underfunded and overwhelmed by what can best be described as a "dog rescue epidemic", yet somehow the find a way to survive and rescue another dog, and another one and another one.

We wanted to pick one story that best illustrates their "never give up" attitude. It's this one, about a sad, sorry, broken, thrown away dog stuck at a kill shelter facing grave circumstances with only ONE way out, The Animal Pad.

He is known simply as "Case A5604627".

How much do we love The Animal Pad? The We Love Doggos Charity just committed to funding and attending TWO additional Mexico vaccination missions in 2024 (500+ dogs total) as well as a monthly stipend to be used for medical expenses and sponsorships of several The Animal Pad fund-raising events.



We can't think of a better way to share our resources than with an organization so fully committed to making the world a better place for dogs.

The fastest time to pop 100 balloons by a dog is 28.22 sec, and was achieved by Loughren Christmas Star (Toby) and Christie Springs (both Canada) in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, on 9 April 2017



Most frisbees caught and held in mouth

Edward Watson's (USA) dog Rose can catch seven flying discs, thrown one at a time, and hold them all in her mouth at once



Most bottles recycled by a dog

As of 2010 a Labrador called Tubby, had helped recycle an estimated 26,000 plastic bottles over the previous six years by collecting them on his daily walks, crushing them and passing them to his owner



Longest tail on a dog

The longest tail on a dog measures 76.8 cm (30.2 in), achieved by Keon who is owned by Ilse Loodts (both Belgium), in Westerlo, Belgium, on 18 August 2015
