

The real threat, he observed, is not Hamas, or Iran, Hezbollah or the BDS. It is the Israeli people's internal fragmentation, their failure to unify, that poses the greatest threat to the future of the Jewish nation.

Following years of careful analysis, academic research, and an extensive military career in the IDF, Samia presents the vital blueprint for ensuring Israel's survival—not just in form, but in spirit. Chief among them: unity in the face of political, demographic, or international conflict.

From foreign policies, education reform, the relationship between religion and state, to economic relief and environmental protection strategies, Samia lays out thirteen cardinal values for Israel as a nation to stand upon if it wants to survive the intense internal turmoil of the coming years, including the seven iron principles that will determine the future of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.
