## Children separated from care, whether on the streets or in orphanages, face:

- ✦ Exploitation & abuse due to lack of stable support
- ✦ Higher risk of child marriage (especially for girls) as a survival strategy
- ✦ Exposure to trafficking & forced labor without legal protection
- ✦ Increased substance abuse & mental health challenges (PTSD, depression)
- ✦ Criminalization due to survival-driven illegal activities
- ✦ Education disruption, limiting future opportunities
- ✦ Long-term poverty & homelessness, perpetuating cycles for generations



Strengthening families through social work support and capacity building ensures safer, more nurturing environments for children.

## Strengthening families and reforming care systems ensures that children thrive:

- ✦ Ensuring permanency and protection through skilled social work, education and support.
- ✦ Helping other orphanages transition to family care.
- ✦ Empowering families with parenting skills, financial stability & resources
- ✦ Preventing separation by addressing poverty, conflict & other root causes
- ✦ Offering alternative care like kinship, foster, and adoption when needed
- ✦ Ensuring permanency through skilled social work & reunification support
