Inspiring Change: Ladli Mahotsav 2024 Empowering Adolescent Girls

As we step into 2025 with renewed hope and commitment, Sewa International continues its mission of creating lasting change with the Ladli Mahotsav 2024, held in Tapovan village, Chamoli district, Uttarakhand. This initiative aligns with the Sustainable Development Goals, focusing on improving access to clean water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) through community-driven efforts.

Themed "स्वच्छ जल, स्वच्छ शौचालय, स्वच्छता हो, हर गाँव-विद्यालय," the Mahotsav aimed to instill good hygiene practices among adolescent girls through interactive sessions, cultural activities, and creative competitions. Over 30 girls were empowered with critical knowledge about Menstrual Health Management (MHM), nutrition, and environmentally friendly hygiene practices. With more than 1,000 participants, the event became a platform for promoting awareness and driving meaningful behavior change.

Workshops led by experts highlighted essential topics, including school sanitation, health risks of poor hygiene, and gender-sensitive WASH practices. Hygiene kits were distributed to ensure access to essential resources, and creative activities like essay writing and poster-making allowed the girls to express their understanding of these themes.

A cleanliness rally involving 500 adolescents amplified the event's message, while 30 trained WASH ambassadors pledged to continue promoting hygiene within their communities. Cultural performances and competitions infused local relevance and vibrancy into the event, ensuring its impact extended beyond awareness to tangible action.

The tree plantation drive stands out as a remarkable step toward sustainability and environmental restoration. A total of 450 trees were planted across Barmer and Jaisalmer, breathing life into barren landscapes and promising a greener tomorrow. In Barmer's Kahu Ka Kheda Gram Panchayat, 200 saplings found new homes at the Government Higher Secondary School, the Gram Panchayat campus, and the local temple premises. Meanwhile, in Jaisalmer's Lawan Gram Panchayat, 250 trees were planted at key locations, including the Government Higher Secondary School, Police Station, Temple, and Crematorium. These efforts, supported by community leaders and enthusiastic participants, demonstrate the power of collective action.

For many students in these districts, the journey to education is a literal uphill climb, with distances ranging from 4 to 19 kilometres between their homes and schools. To ease this challenge, Sewa

International distributed 50 bicycles to deserving students. In Barmer, bicycles were provided to students from Government Higher Secondary Schools in Kahu Ka Kheda, Bhimra, and Hudo Ki Dhani, while students from the Government Higher Secondary School in Lawan, Jaisalmer, also received this much-needed support. These bicycles are more than a convenience—they are a bridge to education, empowerment, and new opportunities for these young learners.

The events were marked by the active involvement of community leaders, educators, and locals, transforming them into celebrations of unity and progress. This included 17 root canal procedures, highlighting the depth of care extended to young learners.

With active support from the Department of Ophthalmology and Dentistry, we brought quality healthcare to the doorsteps of remote communities, empowering them with knowledge to lead healthier lives.
