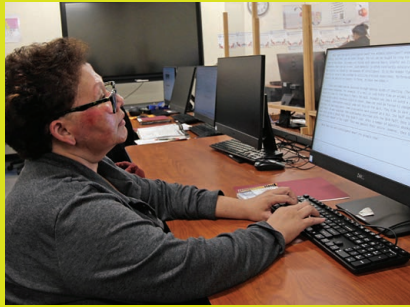

ATTENDANCE

Each student should assume his/her share of responsibility for keeping a class active by being regular in attendance and encouraging fellow classmates and others to attend the class. Courses may be discontinued if attendance drops below an acceptable minimum of students. Adult students are encouraged to attend 90% of the class time.

INSURANCE

Montebello Adult Education does not carry student accident insurance.

TEXTBOOKS

Textbooks are required in some classes. Please check with the instructor to determine whether or not you need to purchase a textbook for your class. The Adult School does not sell books.

STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARDS

Student identification cards are available to all students free of charge. Student identification cards are mandatory for all in-person high school students. If a student's identification card is lost, there is a \$5.00 fee to replace it. The cards may be purchased at the main/front office. We accept credit cards, cash, and money orders.

CLASS FEES

MCAS is committed to providing accessible and affordable educational opportunities to all students. As such, the school does not charge tuition or class enrollment fees for any of its courses.

However, certain Career Technical Education (CTE) programs may require the use of specialized materials, supplies, or equipment that are necessary for hands-on training and successful course completion. In these cases, a materials fee may be assessed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

MATERIAL FEES

- Are limited to the actual cost of consumable supplies or program-specific materials
- Vary by course and program requirements
- Are clearly communicated to students at the time of registration or prior to the start of the course
- Are non-refundable once materials have been issued, unless otherwise stated
- No student will be denied access to a program solely due to an inability to pay material fees. Students experiencing financial hardship are encouraged to speak with school staff regarding possible accommodations or fee assistance options, if available.
- MCAS remains committed to transparency and equity in all fee practices.

REFUND POLICY

All refunds must be approved by a Principal.

Fees are not refundable once the course begins. The only exception to this policy is when the Montebello Community Adult School cancels the class. In this instance, the fees charged for the canceled class will be refunded.

This course introduces students to the language of medicine through the study of word structure, prefixes, suffixes, and root words used in health care. Students will learn to define, pronounce, and spell medical terms related to the body systems, diagnostic procedures, and treatments. Emphasis is placed on building a working vocabulary for use in various medical and allied health settings.

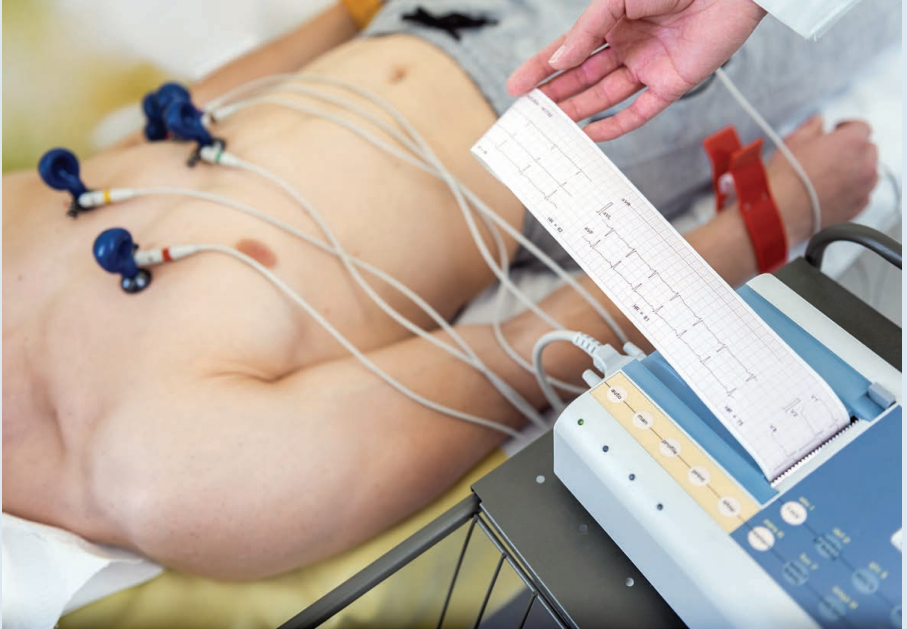

CAREER TRAINING PROGRAMS

EKG CET CERTIFICATION PREPARATION COURSE



This self-paced course is designed to prepare students for the Certified EKG Technician (CET) credential through the National Health Career Association. Intended as an exam-preparation course, instruction focuses on essential cardiovascular anatomy and physiology, EKG fundamentals, rhythm recognition, medical terminology, and test-taking strategies aligned with the CET exam. This course does not include hands-on clinical training or skills practice. Students will progress at their own pace with guided support, building the knowledge needed to successfully sit for the national certification exam.

At the end of the course and upon successful completion of the course, students will take the CET certification exam. Since the exam is offered through NHA, MCAS is not responsible for test results and does not guarantee NHA certification upon completion of this preparation course.

Prerequisite: Highly recommended to have healthcare field experience and/or EKG training.

Fee: \$50

Note: Typically cost of exam through NHA is over \$100.

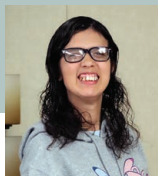
